A one-time \$500 scholarship awarded to a graduating High School senior that resides full time in the Highland Lakes Community, has been involved in a volunteer activity and plans to continue their education at a Vocational/Trade School, College or University.

Purpose

The Goodwill Community Outreach Fund (GCOF) is a passionate, volunteer-driven, 501(c)3 nonprofit organization dedicated to creating a vibrant, multi-generational community where neighbors connect, support and uplift one another. In awarding this scholarship, one of the goals of the GCOF is to create an awareness of the benefits in volunteerism for the young people in our community, hoping they will develop the passion to serve and help others throughout their lives.

Eligibility Criteria for Community Scholarship

- 1. The eligible student must be a graduating high school senior, reside full time in the Highland Lakes Community and continue their education at an accredited Vocational/Trade school or College/University.
- 2. The student must have a minimum 3.0 GPA, current or previous volunteer experience, and an acceptance letter from the school that they plan to attend.
- 3. The applicant must provide a response essay to the 3 prompts in the application. The application will be evaluated on the specific criteria.
- 4. Each applicant **must submit** their latest High School school transcript, an acceptance letter from the school they plan to attend and proof of home address if not listed on the transcript.
- 5. The completed application must be postmarked by May 1, 2025.
